**UIA UPDATE:** Our UIA organizing has led towards a huge step forward for local prevention efforts. Governor Patrick announced a supplemental budget to address crime and violence, which includes \$11 million for the Shannon Grant. In his original budget, the Governor did not include this funding. To address, this, the Boston Globe wrote: Patrick said he agreed to seek immediate funding for the grants after lawmakers helped him "appreciate just how much support and

energy there has been in the past for the Shannon program." The Standard-Times wrote: Gov. Patrick, who did not include the anti-gang money in his budget proposal in February, said supporters convinced him it was the best way to spend the money. It was also funded at \$11 million last session, in its first year. Gov. Patrick said that the Legislature "helped me appreciate how much support and energy there has been in the past for the Shannon program in particular. Those words are magic in the building." It is our organizing and efforts that helped make "Shannon" magic words in the statehouse. UIA and street outreach workers met with most of the legislators in New Bedford and Fall River, gathered at the Statehouse to promote this with other police chiefs, DA's, and mayors (including Chief Teachman and DA Sutter), UIA leaders made phone calls and wrote letters, and Fall River leaders held a press conference. Although this is not yet passed, we should feel good about how far this has come. In February, there was no money for Shannon, now the Governor is filing an supplemental budget for it. **We will have a meeting on Thursday, May 24 at 7:45 p.m. to see what we need to work on this summer. All are welcome!**
