A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR: At our recent parish council meeting it was suggested to me that I write often in the bulletin a note to the parishioners about important topics of interest. I do normally edit the bulletin after our volunteer, Susie Jorge, has typed it, but they noted that many other pastors use an occasional letter as a way to bring something to the attention of the parishioners.

One of the things which was on our minds at the parish council meeting was the **excessive noise** during some recent Masses, especially during the First Communion Mass and at the 10 a.m. and 11:30 Masses. It seems that particularly this is a situation with small children, since the school-aged children have gotten better about talking during Mass. As a priest I am not a parent, but many of the laypeople on the council have children and I did grow up in a family of 4 children. We encourage parents to find ways to control the noise that their children make, which is not often easy, since

one does not always know when an outburst is coming. **Some suggestions** are: taking the child into the area between the 2 sets of doors at the County St. entrance of the church; having mom attend one Mass and dad attending a later or earlier Mass (this is what my parents did); not allowing the children to run back and forth to the lending library. A parent on the council said that we should *also ask parents of young children what suggestions* that you might have.

We have also received some complaints about adults chatting during Mass. The moment of the Consecration **is not the time to chat, but the time to pray**

Once we have received First Communion we have a moral responsibility before God to attend Mass every Sunday (this is part of the 3rd Commandment – “Keep holy the Sabbath”). I am not trying to offend parents, but many parishioners have complained and some have left the parish due to the noise.

A prior appointment with Father Wilson is required. **SPONSOR CERTIFICATES TO BE GODPARENTS:** Godparents **MUST be people who go to Mass Weekly.** If they go here, it would be a good idea to register in the Parish, since it is not easy for the Priest or the Deacon to remember everyone. If they go to Mass at another parish, they should register there. Please pass this information along, so that we don not have embarrassing situations denying sponsor certificates. **When choosing Godparents,** they must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. If they are married, they need to be married in the Church (or with the Catholic Church’s permission in a non-Catholic Church). If they are single, they need to be not “living together” with someone. A non-Catholic can be chosen as one of the sponsors, and would be called a “Christian witness”. They would have to be practicing member of their church. Godparents need to request sponsor certificates from the church they currently attend (not the church of their Confirmation).

UNA CARTA DEL PARROCO: En nuestra reunión del Consejo Parroquial propusieron que yo escribiera una carta de vez en cuando en el boletín para tocar temas importantes. Suelo revisar el boletín después de que nuestra voluntaria, Susie Jorge, lo haya escrito, pero los miembros me dijeron que muchos párrocos escriben una carta en el boletín para llamar la atención de los feligreses a cosas importantes.

Una de las cosas de que hablamos en el consejo era el **ruido excesivo** durante algunas Misas recientemente, especialmente la Misa de la Primera Comunión a las 2 y las Misas de las 10 a.m. y 11:30. Parece que el problema reside en los niños pequeños, ya que los que han estado en el catecismo han mejorado en cuanto a su comportamiento durante la Misa. Como sacerdote, no tengo hijos, pero muchos de los laicos que

son miembros del Consejo tienen hijos y yo me crié en una familia de 4 hijos. Pedimos que los padres de familia encuentren maneras de controlar el ruido que sus niños hacen, que no es fácil de hacer, ya que muchas veces no sabemos cuando van a gritar o llorar. **Algunas sugerencias:** cuando se portan mal, trae el niño a la parte de la iglesia entre las puertas de entrada (todavía en el edificio, pero no en la nave de la iglesia); que la madre asista una Misa y el padre asista otra mas tarde o mas temprano (esto es lo que hicieron mis padres); no dejar que sus niños corran. Una madre en el consejo dijo que también debemos *preguntar a los padres de familia que sugerencias* ustedes tienen.

También hemos recibido algunas quejas de que hay adultos conversando durante la Misa. El momento de la Consagración **no es el momento de conversar, sino de rezar.**

Después de haber recibido la primera Comunión, tenemos una responsabilidad moral delante de Dios de asistir a la Misa cada domingo (esto es parte del 3er Mandamiento – “Guardar el Día del Señor”). No quiero ofender a los padres de familia, pero muchos feligreses han quejado y algunos han abandonado la parroquia a causa del ruido.
