**A WOMAN'S CONCERN:** The Baby Bottle Campaign: Our Lady of Guadalupe at St. James raised **\$2,689.98** through the Baby Bottle Campaign. What a wonderful demonstration of love for life! We sincerely thank you for your efforts on behalf of the women and couples we see every day looking for help with their unplanned pregnancy. Thanks to your sacrifice A Woman's Concern continues to offer these services free of charge.

**EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION- WEDNESDAYS:** *From 7 to 9 p.m.* we will have Eucharistic Adoration, with Night Prayer & Benediction at 8:45 and Confessions offered during the evening. Feel free to come spend a few minutes with Our Lord.

**BAPTISM CLASSES IN ENGLISH** are offered when needed by Deacon Larry. A prior appointment with Father Wilson is required. **When choosing Godparents**, they must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. If they are married, they need to be married in the Church (or with the Catholic Church's permission in a non-Catholic Church). If they are single, they need to be not "living together" with someone. A non-Catholic can be chosen as one of the sponsors, and would be called a "Christian witness". They would have to be practicing member of their church. Godparents need to request sponsor certificates from the church they currently attend (not the church of their Confirmation).

**FOOD DONATIONS STILL NEEDED:** Although no longer much in the headlines, the families affected by the raid at the Michael Bianco factory are still in need of assistance. Since they no longer can work, they are dependent upon the kindness of others until they can straighten out their situations. Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish at St. James Church, with the assistance of people from other churches, continues to provide a food pantry to assist the families, using the former St. Hedwig/NS de Guadalupe Church at 51 Division St. (South End of New Bedford). In terms of donations, we are in need of: Diapers sizes 4,5, and 6; baby wipes; sanitary pads; black beans; vegetable oil; instant coffee; 5 pound bags of sugar; spaghetti; and maseca corn flour. You may bring your donation to St. Hedwig/Guadalupe on Mondays, Tuesdays or Fridays from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. If you have any questions, please call Fr. Wilson or Ana Medina at 508-992-9408.
