BAPTISM CLASSES IN ENGLISH are offered when needed by Deacon Larry. A prior appointment with Father Wilson is required.

SPONSOR CERTIFICATEES TO BE GODPARENTS: Godparents **MUST be people who go to Mass Weekly.** If they go here, it would be a good idea to register in the Parish, since it is not easy for the Priest or the Deacon to remember everyone. If they go to Mass at another parish, they should register there. It is **NOT sufficient** to have gone to Mass here years ago. Please pass this information along, so that we do not have embarrassing situations denying sponsor certificates. **When choosing Godparents**, they must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. If they are married, they need to be married in the Church (or with the Catholic Church's permission in a non-Catholic Church). If they are single, they need to be not "living together" with someone. A non-Catholic can be chosen as one of the sponsors, and would be called a "Christian witness". They would have to be practicing member of their church. Godparents need to request sponsor certificates from the church they currently attend (not the church of their Confirmation). We are running this announcement due to repeated conflicts with people requesting sponsor certificates.

FOOD DONATIONS STILL NEEDED: Although no longer much in the headlines, the families affected by the raid at the Michael Bianco factory are still in need of assistance. Since they no longer can work, they are dependent upon the kindness of others until they can straighten out their situations. Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish at St. James Church, with the assistance of people from other churches, continues to provide a food pantry to assist the families, using the former St. Hedwig/NS de Guadalupe Church at 51 Division St. (South End of New Bedford). In terms of donations, we are in need

of: Diapers sizes 4,5, and 6; baby wipes; sanitary pads; black beans; vegetable oil; instant coffee; 5 pound bags of sugar; spaghetti; and maseca corn flour. ST. PETERSBURG: Cardinal Seán P. O'Malley to Co-Lead Pilgrimage with Orthodox to Rome, Constantinople, and St. Petersburg in Fall 2007. Reservations are still being taken. For further details please call Dr. Vito Nicastro at the Office for Ecumenical and Interreligious Affairs, 617-435-0019.

Highlights are intended to include a general audience with the Holy Father, Great Vespers with the Patriarch of Constantinople, tours such as the Vatican and Byzantine Mosaics of Rome, Hagia Sophia, the Grand Bazaar, Halki, and in Russia the Hermitage, Orthodox Churches of St. Petersburg.

The Pilgrimage will be led by Metropolitan Methodios and Cardinal O'Malley. The Pilgrimage will depart Boston for

Rome on Sunday evening, **September 16, 2007**; fly from Rome to Istanbul on Thursday, September 20, 2007 until Sunday, September 23, 2007. Those not going to St. Petersburg will return to Boston on Sunday, September 23, 2007. For those who would wish to extend their trip to include St. Petersburg, the group will depart for St. Petersburg on Sunday, September 23, 2007, and return to Boston on Wednesday, September 26, 2007. Lufthansa is the air carrier of record. Motor coaches will be provided for airport transfers and for the tours that will be provided. There will also be optional "on your own" tours. All breakfasts and one "family" dinner in each city will be included. We will be staying at good, centrally located hotels for which taxes and portage will be included.

The cost per person on the Rome/Constantinople Pilgrimage is \$3500 based on double occupancy. The per person cost on the Rome/Constantinople/St. Petersburg Pilgrimage is \$4500 based on double occupancy. A single supplement will apply for those who choose this option. All costs are based on double occupancy. All flight seats are coach. If you wish an upgrade to business class, please let us know.
