JUNE IS THE MONTH OF THE SACRED HEART: this year, so as to remind ourselves of the Love Christ has for us in His Sacred Heart, the Men of the Sacred Heart (based out of Fairhaven) will be coming to the parish to share with us the spiritual benefits we can receive by honoring the Sacred Heart as individuals, as a parish, and as families. The schedule will be as follows:

Monday, June 19 – 7:00 p.m. – Spanish Mass - Fr. David Reid: “Familia y entronar al Sagrado Corazón”

Tuesday, June 20th – 7:00 p.m. – English Mass – Fr. Wilson with Deacon Maurice Ouellete preaching “Family and Enthronement”

Wednesday, June 21st – 7:00 p.m. – English Mass, followed by Adoration with talk by Donald St. Gillis: “The Enthronement of the Sacred heart – How it began and the 12 promises of Christ”.

Thursday, June 22nd – 7:00 p.m.- Spanish Mass- Fr. Michael Annunziato; “El Sagrado Corazón”

Friday, June 23rd – 7:00 p.m. – English Mass, followed by Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, Rosary, Station of the Cross, Chaplet of Divine Mercy and other devotions (Coffee & snack will be available to keep us awake); =Eucharistic Procession and Benediction.

Friday into Saturday, June 24th – Midnight Mass- Bilingual

Sunday, June 25th – 1:00 p.m.- Bilingual Mass to consecrate ourselves to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

BAPTISM CLASSES IN ENGLISH are offered when needed by Deacon Larry. A prior appointment with Father Wilson is required. **When choosing Godparents**, they must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. If they are married, they need to be married in the Church (or with the Catholic Church’s permission in a non-Catholic Church). If they are single, they need to be not “living together” with someone. A non-Catholic can be chosen as one of the sponsors, and would be called a “Christian witness”. They would have to be practicing member of their church. Godparents need to request sponsor certificates from the church they currently attend (not the church of their Confirmation).

COURAGE: is a group for people dealing with same-sex attractions while trying to live chastely. Founded by Fr. John Harvey, OSFS, the group is faithful to the Catholic Church’s teachings on human sexuality. The meetings combine prayer and sharing as we walk together in the Lord. The next meeting is on **Saturday, June 17th at 6 p.m.** at the rectory. The meeting lasts around an hour. All are welcome.
