they go here, it would be a good idea to register in the Parish, since it is not easy for the Priest or the Deacon to remember everyone. If they go to Mass at another parish, they should register there. It **is NOT sufficient** to have gone to Mass here years ago. Please pass this information along, so that we don not have embarrassing situations denying sponsor certificates. **When choosing Godparents**, they must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. If they are married, they need to be married in the Church (or with the Catholic Church's permission in a non-Catholic Church). If they are single, they need to be not "living together" with someone. A non-Catholic can be chosen as one of the sponsors, and would be called a "Christian witness". They would have to be practicing member of their church. Godparents need to request sponsor certificates from the church they currently attend (not the church of their Confirmation).

FOOD DONATIONS STILL NEEDED: Although no longer much in the headlines, the families affected by the raid at the Michael Bianco factory are still in need of assistance. Since they no longer can work, they are dependent upon the kindness of others until they can straighten out their situations. We continue to provide a food pantry to assist the families, using the former St. Hedwig/NS de Guadalupe Church at 51 Division St. (South End of New Bedford). In terms of donations, we are in need of: Diapers sizes 4,5,and 6; baby wipes; sanitary pads; black beans; vegetable oil; instant coffee; 5 pound bags of sugar; spaghetti; and maseca corn flour. WHAT EVERYONE SHOULD KNOW ABOUT THE PROPOSED MASSACHUSETTS HEALTH CURRICULUM FRAMEWORKS:

The attached provides you with an excellent analysis of the dangers of this bill. Remember to contact your legislator and ask them to provide input into the Joint Committee on Education to vote "NO" on this dangerous piece of legislation, House Bill 597 and Senate Bill 288. You can call your legislator at 617-722-2000. Please note there are some good aspects to the overall Frameworks. However the sexual components should not be mandatory. Let us teach our children how to read, do math and other things that are truly beneficial to our youth. Parents need to be the ones in control of when children are taught information about sexuality. **In effect, the Frameworks would:**

- contradict the religious, spiritual and traditional values that parents might wish to impart to their children with respect to sexuality, marriage and respect for life (Christians, Muslims, Orthodox Jews, Catholics)
- replace traditional moral values with "politically correct" values;
- eliminate any choice for parents in local communities in determining what would be taught to their children with respect to sexuality, contraception and abortion in public schools

Because parents may not be aware of how radical the Frameworks are, most will fail to opt their children out of these classes.

Students would be taught:

1) how to obtain an abortion without informing your parents

The Frameworks would require us to "Identify and explain laws about reproductive services" (p. 39) Since this could include the Parental Notification laws with respect to a minor's abortion, and the exceptions by way of judicial bypass, they would in effect be teaching students as young as 14 how to obtain an abortion without their parents knowledge.

The Frameworks also require schools to identify resources available for treatment of "reproductive health problems" to students as young as 14 (p. 39). This could include abortion providers, or referrals to such agencies who could explain how to avoid Parental Notification in Mass; these could be agencies that may have a vested financial interest in the outcome of a teenager's decision.
