BAPTISM CLASSES IN ENGLISH are offered when needed by Deacon Larry. A prior appointment with Father Wilson is required. **SPONSOR CERTIFICATES TO BE GODPARENTS:** Godparents **MUST be people who go to Mass Weekly.** If they go here, it would be a good idea to register in the Parish, since it is not easy for the Priest or the Deacon to remember everyone. If they go to Mass at another parish, they should register there. Please pass this information along, so that we don't have embarrassing situations denying sponsor certificates. **When choosing Godparents,** they must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. If they are married, they need to be married in the Church (or with the Catholic Church's permission in a non-Catholic Church). If they are single, they

need to be not "living together" with someone. A non-Catholic can be chosen as one of the sponsors, and would be called a "Christian witness". They would have to be practicing member of their church. Godparents need to request sponsor certificates from the church they currently attend (not the church of their Confirmation).

LETTER FROM THE PASTOR: This past weekend the Church began a special "Pauline Year," in honor of the 2000th anniversary of the birth of St. Paul. Last month we distributed in an insert to the bulletin information on special talks here in New Bedford relating to St. Paul (the notice is still posted on the bulletin board near the County St. door). The Pope is offering **Special Indulgences on the occasion of the 2000th anniversary of the birth of St Paul.** In explaining this concession by the Holy Father, James Cardinal Stafford wrote, "The gift of Indulgences which the Roman Pontiff offers to the universal Church, truly smoothes the way to attaining a supreme degree of inner purification which, while honoring the Blessed Apostle Paul, exalts the supernatural life in the hearts of the faithful and gently encourages them to do good deeds." The Cardinal then explained how we can obtain these indulgences: "**I.** Each and every truly repentant individual member of the Christian faithful, duly absolved through the Sacrament of Reconciliation and restored with Holy Communion, who devoutly makes a pilgrimage to the Papal Basilica of St Paul on the Ostian Way and who prays for the Supreme Pontiff's intentions, will be granted the *Plenary Indulgence* from temporal punishment for his/her sins, once sacramental forgiveness and pardon for any shortcomings has been obtained. The Christian faithful may benefit from the Plenary Indulgence both for themselves and for the deceased." Given that most people cannot travel to Rome, there is a way to receive the indulgence here in America: "**II.** The Christian faithful of the various local Churches, having fulfilled the required conditions (sacramental Confession, Eucharistic Communion, prayers for the Supreme Pontiff's intentions) and in a spirit of total detachment from any inclination to sin, may benefit from the *Plenary Indulgence* if they take part devoutly in a sacred function or in a pious public exercise in honor of" St. Paul; "on the days of the solemn opening and closure of the Pauline Year, in all the sacred places; on other days specified by the local Ordinary, in holy places dedicated to St Paul and, for the convenience of the faithful, in other places designated

by the same Ordinary.” (The Ordinary is the Bishop). “**III.** Lastly, the faithful prevented by illness or another legitimate and important cause, always in a spirit of detachment from any inclination to sin, with the intention of fulfilling the usual conditions as soon as possible, will also be able to obtain the *Plenary Indulgence*, as long as they spiritually join in a Jubilee celebration in honor of St Paul, offering their prayers and sufferings to God for Christian unity.” So, this opportunity to receive an indulgence is especially available to the sick and homebound, who can offer their prayers either for themselves or for someone who has passed away, either someone they knew or for any soul in Purgatory. As the Pauline Year goes along, I hope to share more information with you about it. (Due to the length of this notice, I will write about it in Spanish next week) (Escribiré sobre esto en español el domingo que viene.).
