BAPTISM CLASSES IN ENGLISH are offered when needed by Deacon Larry. A prior appointment with Father Wilson is required. **When choosing Godparents**, they must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. If they are married, they need to be married in the Church (or with the Catholic Church's permission in a non-Catholic Church). If they are single, they need to be not "living together" with someone. A non-Catholic can be chosen as one of the sponsors, and would be called a "Christian witness". They would have to be practicing member of their church. Godparents need to request sponsor certificates from the church they currently attend (not the church of their Confirmation).

Mayor Lang wants every N.B. young person to have the opportunity to spend a safe, productive summer learning, working, and interacting positively w/ the community. Youth aged 14-17 are eligible to participate. The program will consist of a combination of community service, instruction in basic job skills, & personal development workshops, with an emphasis on anti-violence and other issues that youth face today in the City of N.B.

The program will run from Monday, July 10-Friday, August 18. The program will occur at sites across the City of N.B., specific locations will be available when a young person is assigned to a team.

Upon successful completion of the program, each young person will receive a \$250 stipend and a letter of recommendation from Mayor Lang to help him or her secure his or her next job.

Any N.B. young person between ages 14-17 is encouraged to apply. There are no family income guidelines for this program.
