**BAPTISM CLASSES IN ENGLISH** are offered when needed by Deacon Larry. A prior appointment with Father Wilson is required.

**SPONSOR CERTIFICATEES TO BE GODPARENTS:** Godparents **MUST be people who go to Mass Weekly.** If they go here, it would be a good idea to register in the Parish, since it is not easy for the Priest or the Deacon to remember everyone. If they go to Mass at another parish, they should register there. It is **NOT sufficient** to have gone to Mass here years ago. Please pass this information along, so that we do not have embarrassing situations denying sponsor certificates. **When choosing Godparents**, they must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacrament of Confirmation. If they are married, they need to be married in the Church (or with the Catholic Church's permission in a non-Catholic Church). If they are single, they need to be not “living together” with someone. A non-Catholic can be chosen as one of the sponsors, and would be called a “Christian witness”. They would have to be practicing member of their church. Godparents need to request sponsor certificates from the church they currently attend (not the church of their Confirmation).

**DIOCESE IN COMPLIANCE WITH CHARTER:** June 2007 marked the fifth anniversary of the passage of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People by U.S. Bishops at their meeting in Dallas. In the Fall River Diocese ensuring the compliancy of all parishes, entities and programs with the Charter is the responsibility of the Office of Child Protection of Catholic Social Services. Over the past five years this office has processed 12,893 CORI or criminal background checks on employees/volunteers; conducted 12 training workshops for Catholic principals and parish religious education directors; trained 6,946 employees/volunteers in abuse prevention; conducted 25 audits of parish and school abuse prevention programs; and coordinated a national conference on abuse prevention with 80 participants from around the country. Independent auditors have found the Fall River Diocese to be in compliance with the Charter each year since audits became mandatory for U.S. Dioceses in 2003. Most of the provisions required by the Charter were already in place in this diocese since 1993.
