BAPTISM CLASSES IN ENGLISH are offered when needed by Deacon Larry. A non-Catholic can be chosen as one of the sponsors, and would be called a "Christian witness". They would have to be practicing member of their church. Godparents need to request sponsor certificates from the church they currently attend (not the church of their Confirmation).
